DROP

Move hand slowly downwards from in front of the dog's nose with a piece of food/toy to the ground as you bring your LEFT FOOT to your RIGHT FOOT and give the COMMAND - DROP
Hand Signal - From the dogs

nose to the ground



Move hand slowly upwards from the ground stopping in front of the dog's nose as you bring your LEFT FOOT to your RIGHT FOOT and give the COMMAND - STAND

STAY 2 WAYS

Coming from your wall with the RIGHT HAND and stopping in front of the dog's nose.

With your LEFT HAND coming over the top of the dog and stopping in

front of the dog's nose.

COMMAND - STAY


STAND FOR EXAMINATION

(By Instructor standing beside your dog)

With the dog standing on the LEFT COMMAND - STAY.

And stand beside your dog. Instructor will approach from the dog's left hand side. Instructor holds out hand for dog to sniff. Instructor runs hand lightly over the dog's head and back.

After examination instructor steps away, reward and release.



STAND FOR EXAMINATION (By handler beside your dog)

With the dog standing on the LEFT COMMAND - STAY.

And stand beside your dog. Run your hands lightly over the dog's head and back.


After examination stand back up. Reward



DROP FROM FREE HEELING

As soon as the dog understands the DROP command and is steady you can teach it to drop from heel.

With the dog heeling on the left use your RIGHT HAND to give the DROP signal and COMMAND - DROP. Dog should be dropped as your LEFT



DROP STAY

With the dog dropped and on the LEFT COMMAND - STAY.

Step off with your **RIGHT FOOT** and stand in front of the dog. If necessary kneel down with your dog and hold it in the drop position.
